Wheel Elements	Steps	Tasks
Axle	① Plot the IPP.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Preserve IPP ✓ Immediate locale search ✓ If a structure, search and re-search repeatedly ✓ Signcutters/trackers ✓ Tracking/trailing dogs
Rim	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ② Determine subject category. ③ Determine statistical ring. ④ Draw 50% and 95% rings. ⑤ Reduce search area using subjective and deductive reasoning. ⑥ Mark boundary on map. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Establish containment. ✓ Consider camp-ins, road/trail blocks, track traps, patrols, attraction, and string lines.
Hub	⑦ Mark 25% ring if appropriate.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Canvass campgrounds, if appropriate. ✓ Thoroughly search from IPP to 25% when less than 0.2 miles/0.3 km.
Spokes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⑧ Draw travel routes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blue lines (water features, drainages) • Dashed lines (trails) • Black/red lines (roads, man-made features) • Travel corridors (ridges, contours) • Corridor tasks, if appropriate 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Conduct hasty search of trails, roads, drainages, and other travel routes leading away from IPP. <p>Emphasis at likely decision points.</p>
Reflector	⑨ Mark high probability/hazard areas.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Send hasty teams to areas of high probability, high hazard, historic locations of finds.
	⑩ Prioritize and deploy tasks using quick consensus method.
